Another international consultant showed interest but was unable to communicate in Spanish, which limited his ability to interact with staff, so his proposal was not accepted. The results of the consultancy carried out to strengthen the issue of environmental and social safeguards and gender policy were presented to the Board of Trustees for approval and subsequent implementation.

In the diagnosis of the processes, procedures and forms existing of the NATURA Foundation for the identification, evaluation and management of risks and impacts, it was concluded that the incorporation of new principles was required in according with the standard requirements of the different sources of financing to which the organization can have access to carry out projects for adaptation to climate change that benefit vulnerable communities in Panama.

Adjustments were made and implemented to manage A&S risks at all stages of the project life cycle. The application of all these contributions allowed NATURA Foundation to guarantee that the environmental and social risks of the projects are identified, evaluated and valued, from their conceptualization, and the adoption of pertinent measures to avoid or when possible, minimize or mitigate risks during implementation.

The Suggestion and Complaints Management Mechanism, as a tool to promote transparency and accountability of those projects that may generate risks or adverse E&S impacts on communities, was also modified. Complaints and suggestions can be submitted through different channels: NATURA website, email, letter, social networks, telephone, other means that the executors may enable that better adapt to local circumstances.

All the policies are posted on Natura's website and also in the call and contract manuals.
