We are writing regarding the concept notes for the revised SREP sealed pipeline and funding allocation methodology submitted for your review and approval.

The time period provided for submission of comments and any objections to the decision has now expired. No objections were received. We are, therefore, pleased to inform you that the decision below is now approved.

The SREP Technical Committee, having reviewed the document entitled, *SREP Pipeline Revision and Funding Allocation Methodology*, approves the adoption of the procedures to allocate available funds set out in the aforementioned document including a waiver of the requirement to revise an Investment Plan to include new project concepts as specified in the SREP Pipeline Management Policy dated June 2, 2017.
